SUMMER 2025 INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The Turchin Center for the Visual Arts' education and outreach program is committed to connecting university arts resources to a diverse audience of community arts patrons, teachers and learners in the campus community, and in the public, private and home school network across our region. In doing so, the program strives to broaden and deepen arts experiences for audiences of all ages, while ensuring access to the arts for young audiences, building future audiences for the arts, and inspiring a love of learning through the arts.

This summer, we are seeking an intern to invigorate and facilitate the Turchin Center's Moskowitz artmaking space, as well as support additional summer programming. The position responsibilities will include researching current exhibitions and programming, facilitating the Moskowitz artmaking space during open hours, leading a guided tour twice per week, and hosting artmaking workshops. Additional related duties may be assigned. Regular meetings with Arts Education and Outreach and Visitor Services staff members will be required. The position will accommodate 3-6 credit hours at a pay rate of \$13/hr.

Ideal candidates will possess a familiarity with the Turchin Center and its programming and a variety of honed foundational artmaking skills as well as strong leadership, teaching, and public speaking skills.
